The first desideratum is that parents should form a clear idea what is the scientific condition of mind; the next is that they should know in what consists the preparation for it. In proportion as a mind is non-scientific, the occurrence of an unfamiliar phenomenon stimulates it to form some immediate classification or judgment. A new statement is hailed at once as true or false ; a new fact is classified as good or bad, nice or nasty ; an unfamiliar action as right or...
