

A native of Surrey, made scholar of C.C.C. by the Parliamentary Commissioners, October 3, 1648. Elected Fellow, June 8, 1656. Instituted December 22, 1662. His handwriting first appears in the Church Registers in 1665. Three children, baptized at Heyford in 1665, 1667, 1669; buried at Heyford, April 4, 1670. His name, nearly obliterated, is still traceable on a stone near the font. 1670-89. John Franklyn, S.T.B. A native of Wiltshire, Scholar of C.C.C, 1653; Fellow, 1655. His handwriting in the Church Registers begins to fail in 1687. Two years later he died, and was buried within the southeast end of the chancel of the parish church, where, on a limestone slab may still be traced,<sup>1</sup> John Frankline, 16--. 1690-1720. Hugh Barrow, S.T.B. Of Lancashire; scholar of C.C.C, 1663; Fellow, 1673. Instituted May 10, 1690. His handwriting appears in the church registers throughout his incumbency. Buried at Heyford on June 6, 1720, but no memorial of him exists here. 1720-28. Ralph Pomfret, S.T.B. A native of Kent; scholar of C.C.C, 1700; Fellow, 1709. An ornamented marble slab in the floor of the sacristy in the chancel of the parish church marks his grave. 1 This stone has been removed, and is now in the floor of the west end of the south aisle. Radulphus Pom/ret C.C.C., Oxon, nuper socius, Hujus Ecclesiae Rector, Exuvias hie depositus. Obiit 27TM die Julii, Anno aetatis sua 43, 1728....
